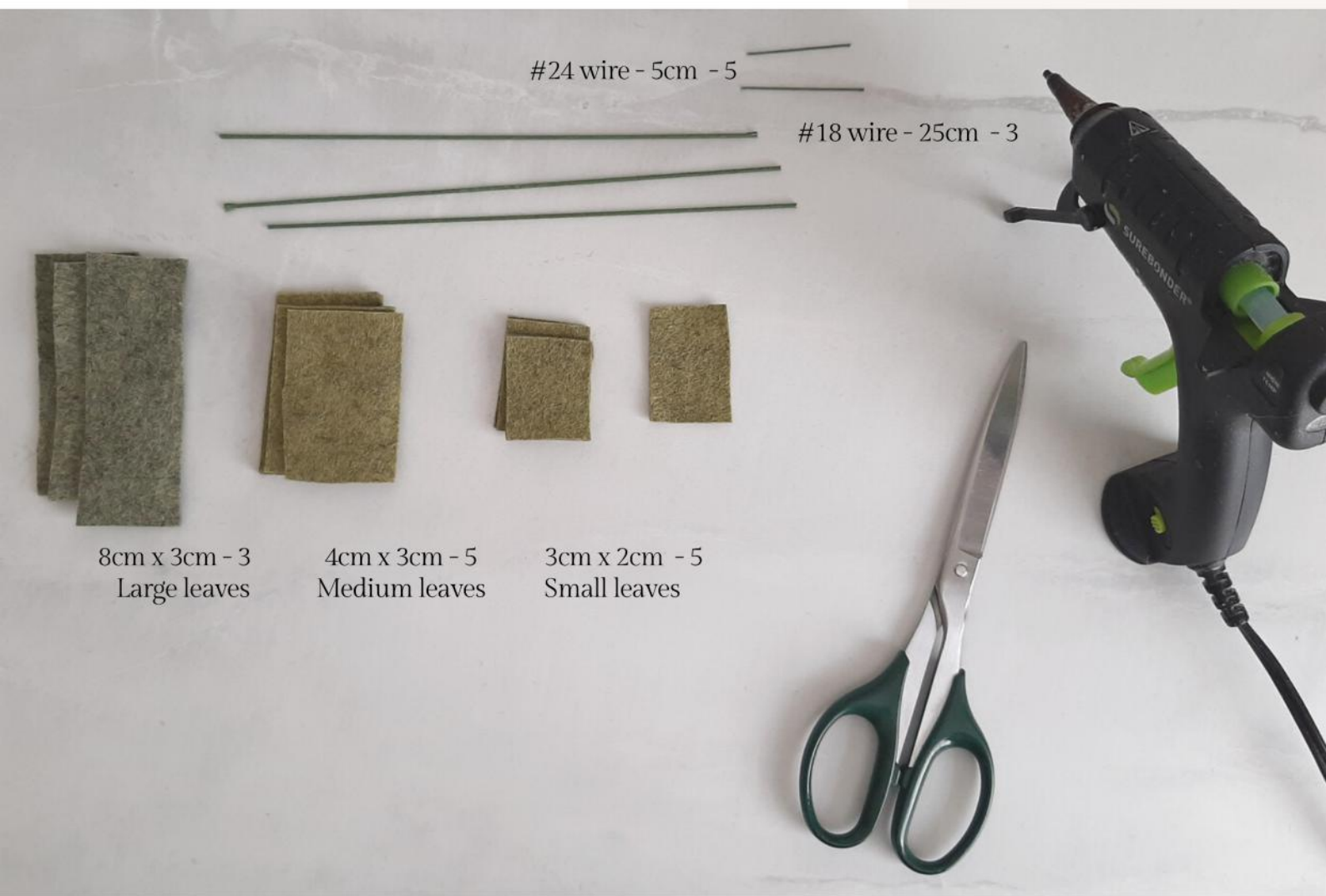

How to make Felt Leaves

Materials

Green Felt : 8cm x 3cm - 3 (Large leaves)
 4cm x 3cm - 5 (Medium leaves)
 3cm x 2cm - 5 (Small leaves)

18 gage green wire : 25cm - 3
 24 gage green wire : 25cm - 5

Wool blend felt is recommended,
 but any types of felt works too.

Tools

Hot glue gun and glue stick
 I use a Surebonder glue gun as it has the finest tip but it's difficult to get if you are in the UK. I used one from Beeway before and I liked it too.
 (Beeway® 20W Mini Glue Gun with 50pcs 7mm x 150mm)

Fabric scissors
 Sharp fabric scissors are essential to work with flower making. Fiskors micro tip scissors are recommended. They are comfortable to hold and not too big, most importantly they are really sharp.

Cutting



1. Cut all the green felt into leaf shapes.

2. Cut slits around the medium sized leaves as shown in picture 2.

Assembling

3. Glue a large leaf and attach to a stem wire (#18 gage- 25cm). Do the same with a medium and small leaf.

4. Glue a large leaf and attach it to a wire (#24 - 5cm) and repeat for the other side. Do the same way for the medium and small leaves.

The picture shows how many you need to make 3 stems of leaves.



Finishing Touch



5. Wrap the paired leaves around the stem. The picture shows how they should at the finish.

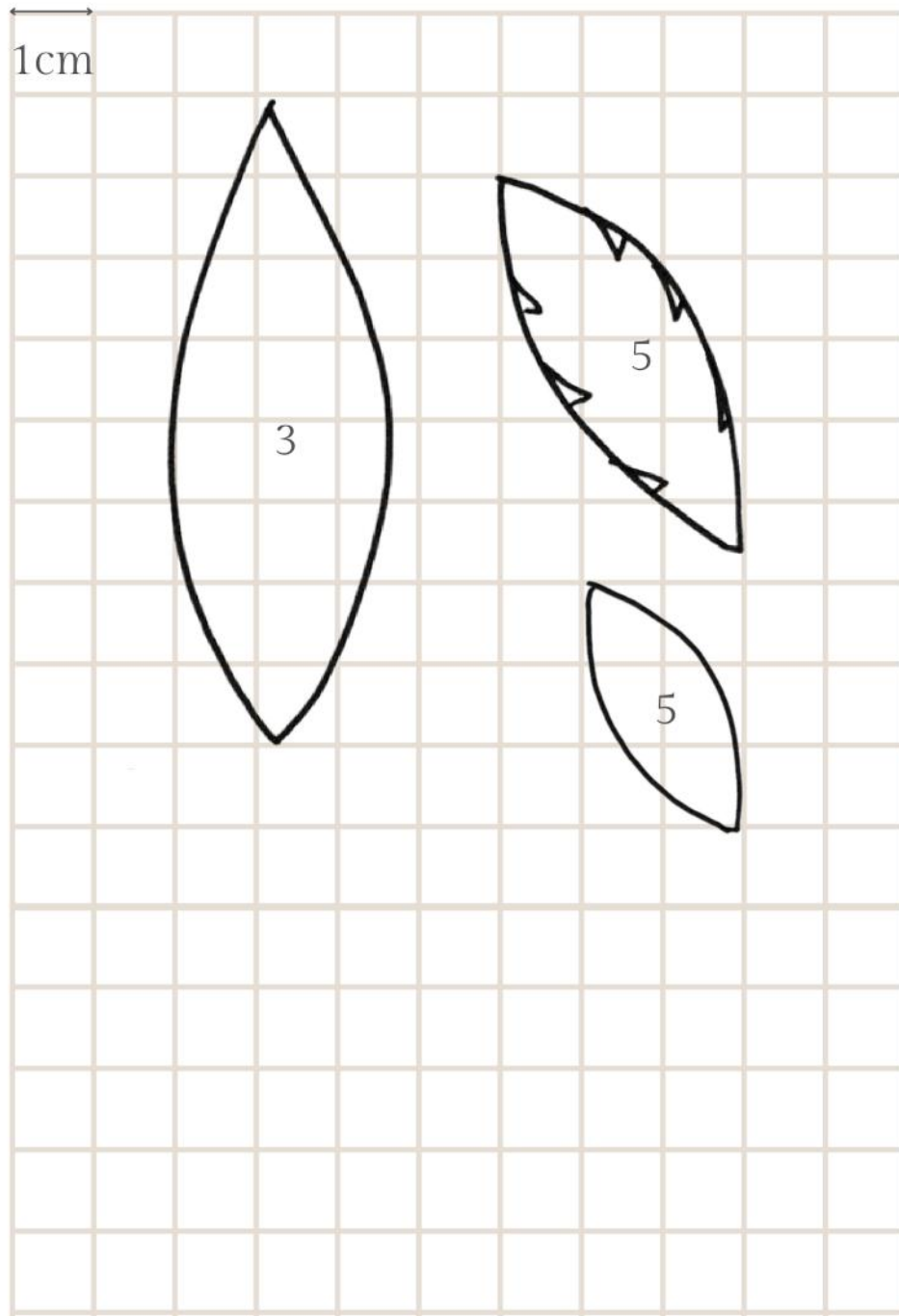


Tips

Leaves are an important part of any floral arrangement. They can be used to fill gaps, add more natural elements, and add a more cohesive look to the overall composition. When arranging flowers, it is often necessary to fill gaps in the arrangement. To do this, leaves can be used as a simple solution.
